

Youth – Friday Night Light

Purpose/Goals of Ministry: What is to be accomplished by this ministry team?	To invite the church into the practice of hospitality by engaging us with teenagers. The goal of our hospitality is surrounding teenagers with disciples of Jesus and inviting them to do the things that disciples do.
What talents, skills, and spiritual gifts would be helpful to this ministry?	An ability to interact with other people, especially teenagers, is helpful
Time Commitment: When & how often do you meet? What other time commitments are there?	FNL meets on the second Friday of each month. Leaders are on site from 6:00-11:15pm.
What specific responsibilities do members of this team have?	Our leaders set up the Christian Life Ministry Center for an open gym and hangout time. Each leader is assigned a specific space to supervise, ensuring safety of FNL participants. We expect our leaders to be “model co-participants”--modeling Christian hospitality and behavior during the night’s events.
Connections: What other ministry teams does this team work with directly?	
Mission: How does this ministry team help people to follow Jesus, love others, and change the world?	Each month, FNL hosts 30-50 un-churched teenagers. We get to extend Jesus’ hand of invitation to these students, inviting them into being co-participants in the Kingdom. We’re practicing love to others to grow God’s Kingdom.
Other: What else do we need to know about this ministry team?	Visits to Waffle House following clean up are optional, but highly recommended (Waffle House at midnight is often a interesting experience).
