To provide, through a long-standing partnership with Globe International and working with local missionaries, day-long medical clinics in rural villages of Nicaragua where residents rarely if ever have access to a medical professional
What talents, skills, and spiritual gifts would be helpful to this ministry?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Medical experience is very helpful but not necessary. We need physicians, physician assistants, dentists, nurses and other medical support staff.</li> <li>• Others assist with patient intake, filling prescriptions, interacting with children, and distributing items such as flip flops, shirts, and toothbrushes.</li> <li>• Fluency in Spanish is helpful but not required.</li> </ul>
Time Commitment: When & how often do you meet? What other time commitments are there?	In addition to the week-long mission (usually done during the summer), there are several meetings beforehand to prepare for the trip. There may also be fundraisers that would require some time and input.
What specific responsibilities do members of this team have?	Varies depending on skills and need: medical work, administrative work, working with children, construction work, and leading Vacation Bible School are all possibilities.
