Purpose/Goals of Ministry: What is to be accomplished by this ministry team?	To provide quality, natural sound amplification and recording in any sanctuary event.
What talents, skills, and spiritual gifts would be helpful to this ministry?	Some knowledge of electronics, wiring, RF transmission, and gadgets.

Mission: How does this ministry team help people to follow Jesus, love others, and change the world?	There are many whose hearing is impaired. This varies widely, and the accurate reproduction of the spoken word is helpful to those whose hearing is impaired. For shut-ins, recordings of worship services is one of their few connections with the church.
