The coordinator makes a schedule of all greeters with their committed dates and telephone numbers. This schedule is sent to each greeter. Greeters are assigned to whichever worship service they typically attend.
What specific responsibilities do members of this team have?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Be in assigned location about 30 minutes prior to the service and remain there until after the first hymn is sung • Welcome all who enter the sanctuary area for worship • Assist visitors to find restrooms, child registration area, and other locations in the church; direct visitors to information booth as needed • If unable to fulfill duties on assigned Sunday, greeters are asked to change with another greeter and to let the coordinator know about the change

Mission: How does this ministry team help people to follow Jesus, love others, and change the world?	By making attendees welcome we hope to keep them coming back and helping to continue the work of the church as they continue to grow spiritually through their times in worship.
