Harris Ipock is the Resident Conductor of the Harvard Glee Club which he joined after completion of his choral-conducting doctoral coursework at the Eastman School of Music. While at Eastman, he served on the faculty of Hobart and William Smith Colleges, where he conducted their Community Chorus, and also worked as organist and choir director at Lakeville United Church of Christ. Harris has taught beginning conducting courses at Eastman and was a finalist for the 2012 Eastman TA Prize for teaching.

Harris enjoys an active career as a soloist and professional chorister. He currently is a member of Conspirare, a five-time GRAMMY-nominated ensemble based in Houston, TX; this group won the GRAMMY in Spring 2015. He has also performed with Publick Musick, Voices, Virginia Chorale, Norfolk Chamber Consort, TodiSingers, and the North Carolina Symphony Baroque Choir. His recent credits as a soloist include Bach's St. John Passion, Cantata 56 and 140, Rossini's Petite Messe Solennelle, Mozart's Requiem, and Handel's Messiah. His opera roles include Count Almaviva in *Le Nozze di Figaro*, John Sorel in Menotti's *The Consul*, Corcoran in *HMS Pinafore*, Sharpless in *Madama Butterfly*, and Cephale in *Jacquet de la Guerre's Cephale et Procris*.
