To transport residents from Cypress Glen Retirement Community to St. James for the 11:00 AM Sunday Morning Service and back after the service. The Bus Ministry is also available for other church groups to transport them to planned activities. Anyone that feels comfortable driving a 14 passenger bus and enjoys
helping older adults would be a helpful volunteer for this ministry.
We do not meet. The regular Cypress Glen transportation on Sunday is on a volunteer to drive basis. You leave the Church at 10:30 AM to pick up the residents to bring them to the service, attend the service, then return them after the service, getting back to the Church around 12:30 PM. Volunteers can drive as little or as often as their schedule permits. Other trips are on an as needed basis.
Drivers must take a training course on the proper operation of the bus, the handicap lift and safety tie-down system and must have a clean driving record and copy of drivers license on file with the Church. Patience is also an important quality as many of our passengers require extra time and assistance.

The Bus Ministry allows people to be involved in worship and spiritual activities. It shows the love we have for each other and the ways we as Christians can make changes.
